Our youth take great pride in every item they prepare!

At Taste of Culture we are celebrating the diversity of San Diego and the many cultures that make up the tapestry of our great City. Although UPAC was originally founded to serve in Asian/Pacific Islander communities, we have grown with San Diego and today we are **U**niting **P**eople **A**cross **C**ultures.
